The regular monthly meeting of the Board of Directors of DeWeese-Dye Ditch and Reservoir Company was called to order by Ron Dorn at the Golden Age Center at 5:00 p.m. Board members attending were Dick Poyner, Honey Moschetti, and Joe Brunetto. Also present was Ditch Superintendent Dave Luscomb.

The minutes from the March, 2011 meeting, were read, and Dick Poyner moved to accept them as printed. Honey Moschetti seconded, and the motion carried.

Bills for the month were reviewed and Dick Poyner moved to pay. Joe Brunetto seconded, and the motion passed.

In the matter of the proposed bridges for Grape Creek, Ron Dorn reported that he had met with the District Manager for BLM. The decision seems to be in the hands of the State Engineer.

The start-up date for 2011 irrigation will be May 2 as reported by Ditch Superintendent, Dave Luscomb.

Dick Poyner reported that the pipe has been installed at Locust and Poplar, the pipe at the Mikus residence has been installed, and the pipe behind Lamborn Storage will still be laid. Work on the wall in the ditch west of the old cemetery will be built soon.

Ron Dorn gave a report on pay-back on winter storage.

Shareholder Bob Barnhill at 1020 Bentley reported that he has problems accessing his head gate from Grand Ave to Bentley, because another shareholder is reluctant to grant access. Dick Poyner offered to try to resolve the problem.

At 5:17 p.m. Dick Poyner moved to adjourn, Joe Brunetto seconded and all voted in favor.
