The regular monthly meeting of the Board of Directors of DeWeese-Dye Ditch and Reservoir Company was held at the Golden Age Center. President Ron Dorn called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. with Board members Dick Poyner, Joe Brunetto, Jim Roberson, and Jeff Boccaccio present. Also in attendance was Ditch Superintendent Luke Miller.

After the minutes were reviewed by the Board, Joe Brunetto moved to accept them as printed. Dick Poyner seconded, and all voted in favor of the motion.

Financial reports for the month as well as the bills were furnished by the Secretary/Treasurer. There were no questions or concerns. Dick Poyner moved to pay the bills, Jeff Boccaccio seconded, and the motion carried.
