President Dorn stated that the Assistant Area Manager Jay Radeford of BLM was trying to get a replacement for the person who had been working on the proposed bridges at Grape Creek.

Additional work was done on the walkway gates at the Lake DeWeese dam. Dick reported that the dam inspector was pleased with the improvements/repairs. Inland Potable has contacted Hydra Gate to make the stem (parts) for the repair to the outlet gate at Lake DeWeese. Hydra Gate will submit drawings for approval and will ship three to four weeks after approval. The work will be performed in the spring of 2014.

In view of the Company's lean checkbook balance, Dick Poyner suggested that work by the surveyor to set monuments at the Lake DeWeese dam be delayed.

At 5:23 p.m. Dick Poyner moved for adjournment. Jim Roberson seconded, and all voted for.
