It was noted by Dick Poyner that irrigation was re-started today.

There were no shareholder problems. Gary Ransom asked if he could haul away some of the rocks stockpiled at the Little Reservoir. He was given permission by the Board.

At 7:20 p.m. Dick Poyner moved for adjournment. Jim Roberson seconded, and all voted affirmatively.
